<p>The <i>Domestic Animals Act 1994</i> requires specific control to the keeping of "RESTRICTED BREED DOGS". <b>RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Proof of microchipping is required for all new animal registrations.</li> <li>* All dogs must be securely confined to your property and wear their registration tags at all times.</li> <li>* Dogs must be leashed at all times within the Borough of Queenscliffe unless being exercised at the Dog Beach designated 'off leash' area.</li> <li>* Your dog or cat must not cause a nuisance.</li> <li>* Your dog or cat must wear the Registration Tag provided at all times, to ensure ownership of the animal can be quickly traced.</li> <li>* If a dog rushes or chases any other person, the owner is liable for a dog rush offence under the <i>Domestic Animals Act 1994</i>.</li> <li>* Cats are prohibited in public areas within the municipality at least safely restrained or contained.</li> <li>* All cats must be desexed prior to registration as required by the <i>Domestic Animals Act 1994</i>.</li> <li>* All cats and dogs over three months must be registered.</li> <li>* It is the responsibility of the dog owner to remove and dispose of their dogs waste when in public places.</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Cats must be securely confined to their owners premises between 8.00pm (eastern standard time) or 9.00pm (daylight saving time) and 6.00am daily – Penalties apply.</b></p>
