CONTEXT

Council recognises the important role that public art plays in a vibrant and attractive community. This policy seeks to support and contribute to the development of a strong arts scene in the Borough of Queenscliffe and to the creation of interesting and attractive public places.

POLICY

In order to support and contribute to the development of a strong arts scene in the Borough of Queenscliffe and to the creation of interesting and attractive public places, proposals for the development of public art, [including temporary or permanent art](#), will be considered against the following principles, which:

- Acknowledges and is receptive to the unique environmental, cultural and historical characteristics within the Borough of Queenscliffe.
- Reflects the identity of the community and is accessible to all.
- Is consistent with planning and heritage policies and codes.
- Builds and/or strengthens partnerships within the community and/or acknowledges a relationship to the wider community.
- Contributes towards the enrichment of public places and public life.
- Enhances the visitor experience and has a positive affect on the local economy.

CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

This policy will be reviewed on a continuous basis, but as a minimum every three years from the date of adoption.
