



Queenscliff Traffic Management Strategy

Engagement Summary

Background

At the Ordinary Meeting of Council dated 28 February 2024, Council resolved to receive the draft Queenscliff Traffic Management Strategy (QTMS), and place it on public exhibition, inviting submissions for a period of 28 days.

The public exhibition period was open from 06 March – 03 April 2024.

Engagement Themes

During the public exhibition period, Council received 6 submissions to the draft QTMS. The recurring themes from these submissions included:

- Hesse Street roundabouts – specifically pedestrian safety and vehicle movements
- Movement & Place Framework and how this is applied in a local context
- Freight and heavy vehicle movements through Queenscliff
- Speed humps throughout Queenscliff, and how they are designed and prioritised
- Electric vehicle chargers and where they are located

Furthermore, a number of items raised related to items outside the scope of the QTMS, including:

- Matters outside the study area
- Operational and maintenance issues

These specific issues will be reviewed, and appropriate action undertaken where necessary. However, they will not be incorporated within the updated QTMS.

Next Steps

Council officers are reviewing all feedback and updating the draft QTMS accordingly.

The intent is to seek Council endorsement of the updated draft at the June Ordinary Meeting.
